Your ID and password to both the secure portion of the SAMMPRIS website and the SAMMPRIS iDataFax data management system will be emailed to you at the address you provided in #3 above. Your password will be autogenerated by our iDataFax computer, and will be applied to access of both system locations.

iDataFax: When you first log on to the iDataFax system with the password and ID you receive, you will be prompted (and required) to change your password to a new one of your choice. Passwords in the iDataFax system expire every 90 days for security purposes as required by FDA regulations, so you will be prompted to change your password the first time you log in after 90 days from your last password change. In the event you have any password issues at any time during your use of the system, email support@sammpris.org for assistance.

Secure website: The autogenerated password for iDataFax will also be applied to the secure portion of the SAMMPRIS website. You will not be able to change the password to the website. If you want a different password once your ID access has been established, email a request to support@sammpris.org indicating the password you wish to use for the website. Website passwords will not expire, and any future change to your password will require a similar email request.
